Two important celebrations rooted in early English history will be observed in 2012. Family-friendly entertainment includes Sir Francis Drake, William Shakespeare, Queen Elizabeth I and her glittering court; puritans, fishmongers, pirates, rogues and wenches engaging guests in feisty banter, gossip and spirited play; jugglers, jousters and jesters; the popular cannon-fire ceremony; and ethnic folk dances. Other family-fun activities include hair braiding, crafts, face painting and a petting zoo.

Delicious and savory foods at every turn include such favorites as Toad in the Hole, turkey legs, ribs, bangers, Shepherd's Pye and a plethora of tempting sweets. Adult guests can wash it all down with a hearty ale or fine wine.

In addition to continuous entertainment and food, visitors will find hundreds of artisans and craftspeople selling a wide selection of goods including jewelry, clothing, shoes and costumes; masks; fine art; glass art; pottery, ceramics and sculptures; children's toys; handmade furniture; leather goods; wood, bone and stone wares; metal coins and pewter; spices and teas; and perfumes, oils, soaps, candles and incense.

Established in 1963 in Agoura Hills near Malibu to create a "living history" for school children and their families, The Original Renaissance Pleasure Faire has grown into an annual interactive playground and gallery for some 200,000 participants and guests and has given birth to a nationwide industry. Since its inception, more than five million people from around the world have visited Southern California's Renaissance Pleasure Faire, averaging approximately 20,000 each weekend

Drive approximately 1 mile to 15501 Arrow Highway which will be on the right (0.2 miles past 4th Street). Total travel is approximately 103 miles, 1.5 hours driving time.
