

Celebrity Golf Invitational Benefits Barbara Sinatra Children Center At Eisenhower

The 25th annual Frank Sinatra Celebrity Invitational, benefiting the Barbara Sinatra Children's Center for abused children, tees off February 21-23, 2013. Eagle Falls Golf Course and Fantasy Springs Resort Casino in Indio will host the event, which is one of the longest running and most successful fundraising events of its kind in the Coachella Valley. Starkey Hearing Technologies returns for the fifth year as the title sponsor, and Ken Venturi, one of Frank Sinatra's best friends, will co-host the event along with Mrs. Sinatra.

The mission of the non-profit center is to provide counseling for victims of physical, sexual and emotional child abuse and to focus on prevention, community education and breaking the cycle of abuse. Services are provided regardless of a family's ability to pay.
